Bring your students out on the water for a transforming experience! *Piscataqua* serves as a unique floating classroom, with students of all ages engaged in hands-on learning while exploring the tidal waters of New Hampshire and southern Maine. Each sail will provide a special experience that inspires and stimulates your students.

Our 2.5 hour school sails focus on environmental science and maritime heritage, with students using dynamic equipment while doing real science. In addition to inquiry-based activities, trips include quiet observation and the opportunity to sing chanteys or write in journals.





Students will be immersed in learning:

- Setting the sail and steering the boat
- Exploring human impact to the watershed
- > Towing for plankton, testing the water
- Using engaging tools to do real science
- Trying their hand at navigation
- Experiencing our maritime heritage and marine/estuarine ecology

The nonprofit Gundalow Company offers schools sails onboard *Piscataqua* every week-day morning and afternoon May through October. Our education programs are STEM based and follow guidelines from state frameworks and Principles of Ocean Literacy.
