



Thursday Music Sails on the *Piscataqua*

- July 4** Traditional Irish instrumental music with **Penhallow**: Jeff Murdock, Tyler Buck, Paul DelNero, and Lloyd Allen
- July 11** The five brass players in **Antique Brass** entertain with a range of color and sound that is rich and varied - - on two trumpets, french horn, trombone and tuba.
- July 18** From guitars to concertina, **Jeff Warner and Barbara Benn** exuberantly sing and play music from many traditions, resulting in toe-tapping, back-porch music.
- July 25** **London Julie**, an energetic quartet of seasoned female singers and musicians, bring harmonies and instrumental magic to their collection of maritime songs
- Aug 1** Sharing a love of swingin' music, **David Graf and Kent Allyn** bring their guitars and harmonies for a special acoustic evening, including blues, jazz and swing.
- Aug 8** Seacoast musicians **Lex and Joe** (Lex Romane, Joe Rillo) use diverse instrumental timbres to offer contemporary rhythm and blues with a range of musical textures.
- Aug 15** The **Short Brothers** "do bluegrass right", with hot pickin', and tight three part harmonies. They really shine together on fiddle, banjo, guitar, and mandolin.
- Aug 22** **High Range** is a roots/folk/bluegrass group that mixes originals with covers on guitar, upright bass, mandolin, fiddle, banjo and drums. Their high energy music brings you the soul of working-class New Englanders.
- Aug 25** **Gordon Bok**, renowned folksinger, will play for a **special Sunday afternoon concert**. His repertoire consists of ballads of Maine and the Maritimes, stories of boats and sailors, contemporary songs and instrumentals.
- Aug 29** Playing Northern Roots music, the ensemble **Sparrow's Joy** covers everything from traditional New England to Scottish, playing mandolin, fiddle, whistle, guitar and bodhran.
- Sept 5** Spawned on the shores of our own tidal rivers, **Drowned Valley** brings a harmonic mix of old banjo music, classic bluegrass, and country ballads.
- Sept 12** A **Sylvan Roots** performance is enhanced with artistically arranged interpretations of contemporary and traditional folk songs on guitar, banjo and percussion.
- Sept 19** "**Two Old Friends**", Jim Prendergast and Emery Hutchins, offer an entertaining mix of plaintive ballads and footstomping shout tunes; soaring instrumental solos, and traditional Irish tunes.
- Sept 26** An evening of folk and acoustic roots music with **Susie Burke and David Surette** on guitars, mandolin, bouzouki and harmonies.
