Bring your students out on the water for a transforming experience! The gundalow Piscatagua serves as a unique floating classroom and lab, with passengers of all ages engaged in hands-on learning while sailing on the tidal waters of New Hampshire and southern Maine.

Your class will explore natural and cultural history at interactive stations and will work as a team to set the sail, steer and navigate. Our enthusiastic educators will help students make connections to the environment as they work with them to establish a sense of place.





School sails last 2.5 hours and focus on environmental science and maritime heritage, using dynamic education tools such as water quality instruments, plankton nets, watershed models, maps and compasses. In addition to inquiry-based activities, these trips include time for quiet observation and the opportunity to sing chanteys or write in journals. Each sail will provide a special experience to inspire and stimulate your students.

The nonprofit Gundalow Company operates the *Piscatqua* in the tidal region of New Hampshire and southern Maine, offering school sails, private charters and public trips mid-May through October. Our education programs follow guidelines from state frameworks, Principles of Ocean Literacy and STEM recommendations, each experience can be customized to meet your curriculum needs.
