ART SCAVENGER HUNT

Overview: Get outside and look for cool things in nature and capture them using different art mediums.

Part 1: First we are going to draw using a pencil, marker, or whatever drawing tool you want to use.

Find a leaf with an interesting pattern and draw it below.

Find a tree that has an interesting trunk or branches and draw it below.

Find a plant that has flowers blooming and draw the flowers

Find a rock that has a cool or interesting shape and draw it below.

Find an animal and draw it (if you don't get a good enough look at it to draw it, you can look up a picture of what it is once you identify it)

Find something while you are out looking for all the other things on the list and draw it

Part 2: Nature Print

For this part you are going to need

- Paint
- Brushes
- Paper (to paint on)
- Newspaper/ Paper (to cover your work area and keep it clean)
- Leaves, rocks, twigs, and anything you want to use for imprints

Paint the color you want to use on the leaf or object you want to use (not too much if you want to see more detail from the object). Press it onto the paper. If you want to layer different imprints on the same page, let the first one dry before you paint the second leaf or object on the paper.

You can do other objects besides leaves. Try rocks, acorns, or twigs and see what patterns they make.

Try and be as creative as you can with what things in nature you can find. Be sure to clean up and keep the paint contained to your workspace!
